

Household Hazardous Waste Collection Locations:

Household hazardous wastes can be taken to the Household Hazardous Waste-mobile, the Auburn Super Mall Wastemobile, and the hazardous waste collection site in Factoria 13800 SE 32nd Street, Bellevue. 8 am - 4 pm Tuesday - Friday and 9 am - 5 pm Saturday and Sunday (except major holidays).

There is a 50 gallon limit and a gasoline limit of 30 gallons per customer per day and customers will not get their containers back.
