Online Survey

Prior to the convening, industry stakeholders will be sent an online survey to complete. The survey will collect feedback about specific patient navigation / care coordination skills and competencies that may be desirable along a continuum of healthcare roles.

On **July 14th, King County partners** will convene to review survey results and respond to proposed curricula design components, drawing from several existing programs that have been piloted in WA state and other areas of the country. These gatherings will be repeated across the state to collect broad stakeholder input.

End Results

The end result will be a credit bearing set of courses/modules offered through our Washington State community and technical college system that will be available in 2015.
