Children's Administration is currently recruiting for a dynamic, motivated, and culturally competent **non-permanent Social and Health Program Consultant 3 - Commercially Sexually Exploited Children Liaison located at the Division of Children and Family Services office in downtown Seattle, Washington.**

The majority of time will be spent in King County and travel is involved. The supervisor is Jami Belieu.

DUTIES:

This position will work primarily out of King County, but will also provide guidance and direction for Region 2 regarding Commercially Sexually Exploited Children (CSEC). The position will address the implementation of CSEC policy and procedures for King County and train and provide guidance to Region 2 regarding CSEC issues and identification of children commercially sexually exploited.

This position will provide the connection between the Community Outreach Specialist and youth who are sexually exploited or at risk of sexual exploitation that are involved in out of home care

with Region 2 South Children's Administration. This position will be the point of contact for all CSEC related questions within Children's Administration Region 2 South. This position will work closely with the King County CSEC Program Manager, King County Law Enforcement and other advocacy agencies. This position will have work assignments regarding children missing from care and coordinate CSEC services and safety planning with assigned staff as necessary.

QUALIFICATIONS:

A Bachelor's or Master's degree in social work, a health or social science, public administration or related field **AND** at least one year of experience as a Social and Health Program Consultant 2 or Social Service Specialist 3 (formerly Social Worker 3) or Financial Services Specialist 4 or above;

OR

A Bachelor's or Master's degree in social work, a health or social science, public administration or a related field, **AND** two years experience as a Work First Program Specialist or equivalent work experience with automated eligibility systems;

OR

A Bachelor's degree in social work, a health or social science, public administration or a related field **AND** four years of professional experience in planning, administering, developing, or delivering social, financial or health services programs;
