Native arts & crafts, food, and community social service programs and services are invited to join this year's festival as a vendor. As part of Seattle Center's year-long Festal cultural celebration, the **Spirit of Indigenous People** Festival showcases cultural and traditional performances, exhibits and activities of American Indians, Alaska Natives and First Nations People.

There is no charge for vendors to host a booth but Seattle Center requires a 10% fee of all vendor sales, to be collected at the end of the day. Electrical power, tables, chairs and a limited number of display hardware are provided. Passes will be available for loading and unloading.

The City of Seattle requires vendors to have a business license. If you do not have one, the Seattle Indian Health Board may make arrangements to cover your activities under our agency's master license.
